Summary

This position performs and assists in plant maintenance, operations, and construction required to maintain and improve plant capacity and quality of finished products. This position reports directly to the Maintenance Supervisor or other equivalent inter-campaign supervisor.

Essential Job Duties

- Ability to train employees as a Mechanic IV in NCCER levels that have been successfully completed
- Execute PM rounds correctly
- Knowledge of Kiosk locations
- Able to work with the Storeroom following their policies, procedures, and processes properly
- Assure that all work areas are kept clean within the food safety, feed safety, and sanitation guidelines (GMP)
- Complete administrative tasks, duties, and reports as required in a timely manner
- Develop the process and mechanical skills of self and others through training
- Able to use mobile equipment to perform assigned tasks
- Use people, time, equipment, and material in the most efficient manner.
- Report mechanical, electrical, instrumentation, environmental, food safety, feed safety, and operational problems, and unsafe conditions to supervisor
- Perform other work as directed by supervisor
- Embrace teamwork
- Other duties as required by the business
- Good attendance, safety, disciplinary, and overall employment records
- Adhere to all company policies and all safety, food safety, feed safety, and sanitation rules and programs

- Knowledge and willingness to follow all safety policies and procedures to insure personal and co-worker safety under all elevations, conditions and situations
- Physically capable of using all safety equipment required to work safely, and physically capable of safely performing all maintenance tasks
- Ability to read and understand written information including manuals, schematics and blueprints and to use good individual judgment without constant, direct supervision
- Organized with excellent time management skills
- Ability to communicate effectively and work cohesively with employees at all levels
